# OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012  
033/OFF/548/2022

**Pursuant** to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the **Act**), DAVID MAINE HOLDINGS LIMITED (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 243 Devon Street West NEW PLYMOUTH 4310 and known SUPER LIQUOR ON DEVON, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

If this licence is not endorsed under section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

Conditions
The <b>OFF LICENCE</b> be renewed for three (3) years from the date of expiry <b>12 April 2023</b> .
Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours: <b>Monday to Sunday 8:00am to 9.30pm</b>
No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on the premises on <b>Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day</b>
The <b>ENTIRE PREMISES</b> is designated as <b>SUPERVISED</b> .
The licensed area of the Off Licence for the sale of alcohol is limited to the floor area within the <b>Bottle Store as marked on the plan reference CLQ22/45157</b> .
A properly appointed certificated or Acting or Temporary Manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises.
Drinking water is to be freely available to customers, while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises.
The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
